(A) Name of the Post: TGT: Physical Education Teacher (Male & Female).

Educational and other qualifications:

Essential: Bachelor's Degree in Physical Education from a recognized university or equivalent with a minimum of 50 % aggregate marks or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University/ institution's norms).

(B) Name of Post: PREPARATORY TEACHER

Educational and other qualifications:

Essential:(i) Sr. Secondary School Certificate/ Intermediate or its equivalent with 50 % marks or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University/ institution's norms).

(ii) Full time Diploma in ECCEd./NST/PPTT from a recognized Institution with a minimum of 50 % aggregate marks or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University/ institution's norms) **OR** two years Diploma in Education (D.Ed.) or Bachelor in Elementary Education (B.El.Ed.) or B.Ed.

(iii) English as a subject in Class XII is mandatory.

(iv) Proficiency in teaching in English medium.

Desirable: Proficiency in teaching in Hindi medium.
