Note: All the concession mentioned above will be concurrent i.e. if a person is eligible for more than one concession, only one of the concessions of the highest permissible limit will be granted.

### 3. General Information for all categories of teacher posts:

i	Candidates with M. Sc. / M. A. / B. A. & B. Ed from NIE with desired subjects or higher qualifications are also eligible.
ii	Competency to teach the concerned subjects through English medium is required. Knowledge of computer applications is desirable.
iii	Candidates must apply separately for each post (if applying for more than one post) along with photograph & photo copies of testimonials & submit the same at the time of registration.
iv	The SC/ST/OBC/PH candidates should submit self-attested copy of a required caste/PH certificate in the prescribed proforma with the application.
v	No TA/DA will be paid for attending the written test and skill test.

Note: i. For all the advertised posts, the Answer Script of Part – II of the candidates will be evaluated only if the candidate qualified Part I of the written test by securing minimum 3 marks each in English and Hindi subjects separately and 07 marks in aggregate.

ii. Negative marking will be applicable in Part II of the written Examination Test. 0.25 marks will be deducted for each wrong answer.

iii. **Mode of Selection:** (a) UR candidates scoring 50 % and above and SC/ST/OBC/PWD candidates scoring 45 % and above in the written test (Part-II) will be eligible for short listing for skill test. (b) The skill test will only be of qualifying nature and will be conducted on Go/No-Go basis for the candidates qualified in written test and short listed for skill test. (c) Candidates who qualify in skill test will be short listed and empaneled in order of merit based on marks secured in part – II of written test.

iv. Tie Breaker: In case of tie between candidates scoring same marks in Part-II of written test and who get a 'Go' in skill test, the tie breaker is decided as follow: (a) First Tie Breaker: Whoever gets more marks in Part- I of the written test is ranked higher. (b) In case where the marks of written test part-I are equal then the candidate senior in age is ranked higher.
