In order to commemorate the 129th birth anniversary of a mathematics legend, Shri Srinivasa Aiyangar Ramanujam on 22 December 2015, the school organized **2nd Ganit Week** from **16 December to 21 December 2015**, as per the guidelines given by the CBSE. The main purpose of this week was to sensitize students about the use of mathematical concepts in our day to day life. The week-long programme aimed at involving maximum number of students in various competitions such as quizzes, puzzles, Sudoku, cubes and magic square, etc. The Ganit Week commenced with the introduction of the same by Mr. K.
