## Guidelines for the Literary Club in the School Library for the Session 2018-19.

1. Every reader should have library note book. Evaluation of best reader is strictly based on records. Previous year's library notebooks may be continued till it is over.
2. Books borrowed and read will be verified by the librarian. Note of the same should be written in the School Calendar on the sheet provided for the purpose under the head **The Library Books "I" Read** (Page No. 71).
3. Questions may be asked by the librarian to verify whether book is read or not or borrowed only for the sake of registering the same on records.
4. **For class VI to VIII** – Collection of various information, questions & answers of GK, storytelling during library periods, summary of story, text, poetry etc. These should be in written form in library notebook in reader's own words.
5. **For classes IX & X** – Book review, story writing, articles, collection of information, preparation of presentations on topics of their studies etc. Publication of stories, articles etc. in National/International level magazines/journals, AECS, Kakrapar/AEES News Letters/Magazines etc will give additional weightage to the candidature.
6. **For Classes XI & XII** – Book review/article writing, presentation on subject areas etc.
7. Publication of their individual work on poetry, stories, novels, articles etc. will be appreciated as an added advantage during competition.
8. Summary of story, books read, wrote in library notebook on each borrowing is must for each and every student.
9. Internet downloading or collection from any other readymade source will not be entertained in any condition.

Based on the above parameters a panel of judges or jury will decide the positions viz. first, second, third and consolation for each classes VI-XII. And the prize money will be equivalent to CCA Individual prizes.

In addition to that prizes one **"Best Reader"** award will be given to a student among all winners from standard VI-XII and the award is equivalent to the first position of Academic Excellence.
