**Mode of Selection :**

- (a) Written test of 50 Multiple choice questions of 01 mark each in the respective subject for 1 ½ hours. UR candidates scoring 60 % and above and SC/ST/OBC/PWD candidates scoring 54 % and above in the written test will be eligible for short listing for skill test.
- (b) Skill Test – For the candidates short listed on the basis of written test.
- (c) Candidates who qualify in skill test will be shortlisted and empaneled in order of merit based on marks secured in written test.

- (1) Results of the written test will be declared on the same day at 11.15 a.m. followed by skill test.
- (2) Candidates must apply separately for each post (if applying for more than one post) along with passport size photograph & photocopies of testimonials & submit the same at the time of registration.
- (3) If a candidate has applied for more than one post, sufficient time will be given to complete each written test.
- (4) The SC/ST/OBC/PH candidates should submit self-attested copy of the Caste/PH certificate in the prescribed proforma with the application.
- (5) No TA/DA will be paid for attending the written test and skill test.
- (6) Canvassing of any form will be a disqualification.
