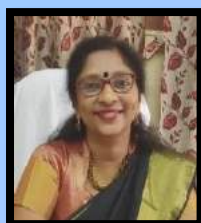

## Online Competition on Preparation of Communication Material on NEP 2020



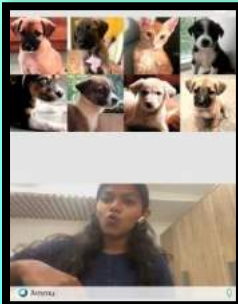

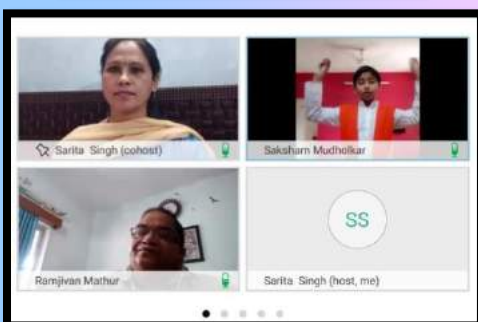

### Literary Activities:

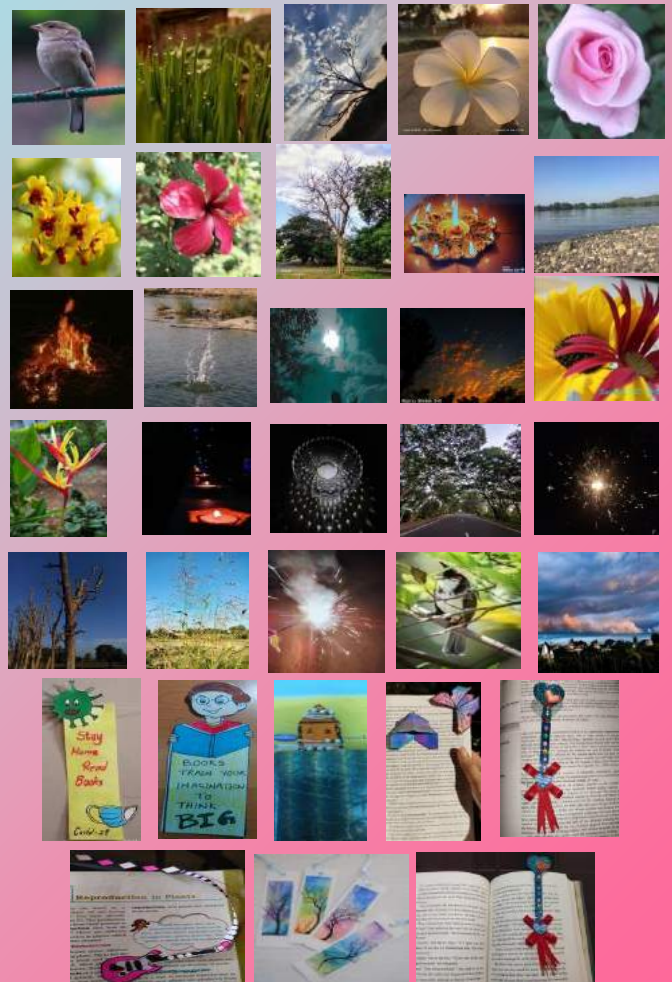

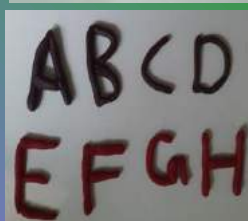


Photography skills and book mark activities by the students

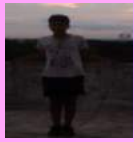

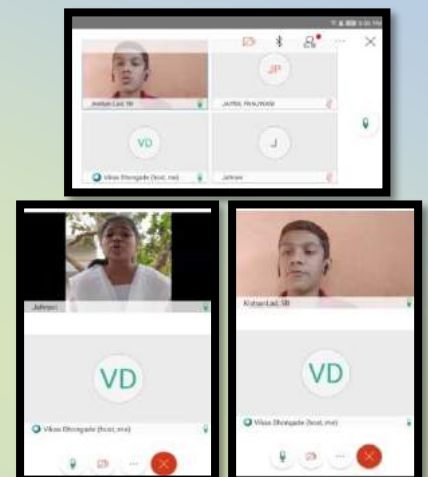

## Co-curricular Activities



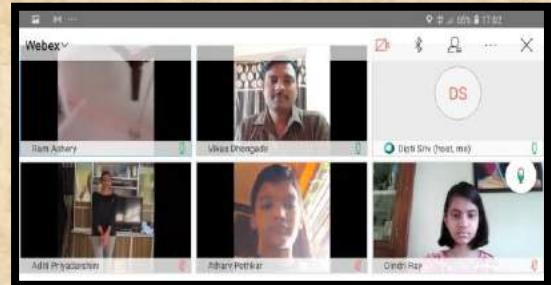
**Online Vegetable Carving Competition**
